Alloya's Annual Leadership Symposium to be Presented Virtually in 2020

Naperville, Ill. (July 23, 2020) – Due to COVID-19, the 2020 Credit Union Executive Leadership Symposium will be held virtually from September 10-11. Although credit union executives from across the nation will not be able to gather in Chicago, IL for Alloya Corporate FCU's sixth annual Symposium, the corporate looks forward to hosting the event online and providing the same great education to credit union leaders – all free of charge.
